



PCE UNEDasiss Calendar

2026 / 2027 Session — Dates, Deadlines, and Preparation Plan

This guide brings together all the information you need about the UNEDasiss Specific Skills Tests (PCE) sessions for the 2026/2027 cycle: registration dates, exam dates, publication of results, and — most importantly — when to start preparing each part of the process so you reach the session with a comfortable margin.

Important notice about the dates

UNEDasiss publishes the official calendar for each session a few months in advance. As of today (September 2026), the exact dates for the ordinary May/June 2027 session and the extraordinary September 2027 session have not yet been officially published.

The 2027 dates shown in this document are an estimate based on the pattern of previous sessions (deadlines tend to fall in very similar weeks each year). They must be confirmed at unedasiss.uned.es as soon as UNED publishes the official calendar, normally between November and February.

Extraordinary session — September 2026 (already held)

Session already held; kept as a reference of real deadlines to estimate the 2027 sessions:

Item	Date
Registration	July 1–22, 2026
Exams (Spain)	September 2–8, 2026
Publication of results	Estimated deadline: September 16, 2026
Appeals period	3 business days from publication of results

Ordinary session — May/June 2027 (estimated)

Estimate based on the calendar of the May/June 2026 session. Pending official confirmation from UNEDasiss.

Item	Date
Registration (collaborating institutions)	Approx. mid-February – end of April 2027
Registration (independent students)	Approx. mid-March – end of April 2027
Exams in Spain	Approx. last week of May 2027
Exams abroad (Americas, Canada, Asia, Oceania)	Approx. first half of June 2027
Publication of results	Approx. last week of June 2027
Appeals period	3 business days from publication of results

Extraordinary session — September 2027 (estimated)

For those wishing to raise their grade or who did not sit the exam in May/June. Estimate based on the September 2026 calendar:

Item	Date
Registration	Approx. July 1–22, 2027
Exams (Spain)	Approx. first week of September 2027
Publication of results	Approx. mid-September 2027

The higher grade of the two sessions (May/June and September) is the one recorded on the UNEDasiss transcript.

Preparation plan: when to start each task

Recommended order of tasks to reach the May/June 2027 session without last-minute stress (adjust if your target is September 2027):

When	What to do
As soon as possible (now)	Start the Bachillerato (high-school diploma) recognition process if it isn't already underway: it is the slowest step (legalization/apostille, sworn translation, filing the application). It can take several months, so don't wait for the PCE registration deadline.
September – October 2026	Decide on your target degree and university, and choose your PCE subjects (up to 6) based on weightings and cut-off marks. This is the decision that most shapes the rest of your preparation.
October – December 2026	Start studying the theory for each chosen subject (maths, chemistry, biology, etc.). Four to six months of lead time before the May exam lets you progress without rushing.
January – February 2027	Consolidate the theory and start practicing with past session exams for each subject.
When registration opens (approx. February–March 2027)	Register for the May/June session as soon as the window opens, without waiting until the last day (avoids seat shortages or technical issues).
March – April 2027	Timed mock exams by subject and review of the weakest points.
April – May 2027	Final intensive review: full mock exams, review of common mistakes, adequate rest in the days before the exam.
May 2027	Ordinary session exams.
June 2027	Check published results; if applicable, submit an appeal within the 3-business-day period.
July 2027 (if needed)	Register for the September extraordinary session to raise your grade or retake subjects.

Final recommendations

- Always check the official calendar at unedasiss.uned.es before making important decisions: dates can vary from one year to the next.
- Don't wait until the last day to register: there may be technical issues or a shortage of seats at some test centers.
- Diploma recognition and subject selection should be settled as early as possible, since they determine everything else.
- Keep your registration confirmation and check it again close to the exam date, as the test center and schedule may change.
